I. CERTIFICATE COURSE OF MANAGEMENT & TRAINING FOR LEARNING DISABLED

Mode of Education — Distance Learning

Registration & Prospectus: Rs. 500/-

Course Fees: Rs. 10,000/-

Duration: 6 months. (Usually from March to August Every Year)

Course Details

Learning Disability is a generic term that refers to a heterogeneous group of disorders manifested by significant difficulties in the acquisition and use of listening, speaking, reading, writing, reasoning or mathematical abilities

Prevalence

Children suffering from Learning Disabilities have grown to be the largest

category of exceptional learners. At least 20 to 25% children in normal, primary and middle schools suffer from Learning Disability, i.e. Language and mathematical difficulties.

Objectives of the Course

- The course is designed to facilitate the identification of learning disability/ disabilities
- Developing the skills for handling various kinds of learning disabilities such as those in the learning of language (e.g. reading, writing, spelling and comprehension) and mathematics (dyscalculia).
- Helping trained personnel to help the students in enhancing their Academic Achievement and percentage of marks in various subjects as a result of reduction in language and mathematical disabilities.
- Reducing the possibility of developing secondary Disabilities and behavioral problems.
- Increasing Cognitive abilities
- Improving the quality of life of the Target Group and consequently their families.

- Information and Awareness of prevalence of LD in Elementary classes or Pre-elementary classes (20-30%)
- Identification, Diagnostic Assessment and Remediation.

Course Structure

The course is designed to include sending of lessons by Correspondence, Assignments, Field Work, Written test and Personal Contact Program in addition to their forms of presentation. Throughout the Course, Theory and Practice will be integrated. Professionals will be encouraged to pool experiences and draw on the support of the colleagues.

Requirement for Admission

Graduate in any subject, preferably with six months experience of teaching or dealing with children. Preference will be given to the-professionals and serving teachers in recognized primary or middle schools, teaching languages / mathematics. Admission will be done on

the basis of academic merit and teaching / work experience. The number of seats is 200 for this course on first come first serve basis.

Requirement for Completion

The achievement of the persons joining the course will be tested through (i) Regular completion of assignments. (ii) Objective type-Written test and (iii) practical examination after the completion of PCP.

It will be compulsory for all to attend PCP, as during this period training in identification, handling and managing the children with disability will be given. Hence, PCP is-an essential part of the Courses (venue for PCP will ordinarily be at Chandigarh) it would include one week's internship / teaching practice in an Institution.

Accommodation may be arranged as per requirement and suitability of the trainee at his / her own cost.

Fees

In addition to the course fee as provide on the top, the candidate will be required to pay additional fee for the video-cassettes, the training kit and any other material to be supplied during PCP or later on.

Identity Card

Trainees will be issued an identity card by the association after their admission to any of the above courses are confirmed. They should produce the Identity card issued to them on demand during contact classes and the examinations. Students are instructed to keep the identity cards safely till the completion of the course. The students can obtain a duplicate card on requisition along with a demand draft of Rs. 50/- and a stamped and signed photograph, in case the identity card is lost.

Despatch of Lessons / Correspondence Material

Lessons will be dispatched usually after two weeks of the admission or earlier. They are advised to correspond with the. Director of the Course / President of INPA if they do not receive the lessons within a reasonable Period of time.

Response Sheets/Assignments

Trainees will be informed about the number of assignments to be submitted in each paper as and when the lessons for various papers are sent. The assignment/s may be in the handwriting of the trainees concerned or typewritten but duly signed by the Trainees.

Application Process

Prospectus including Syllabus and application form may be obtained from the office or INPA against the payment of Rs 300 /- by bank draft / pay order payable Indian National Portage Association at the State Bank of India, Punjab university, Chandigarh or can be paid in cash at INPAs office. The application form has to be submitted with the following enclosures:

- Certificates from 10th to Graduation along with the detailed marks list duly attested.
- · Additional Qualifications, if any.
- Attested copies of another course done along with the marklist.
- 2 passport sized Photographs.
